MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS

Membership entitles members to:

- A key to the door and shed. Note: Junior members are not eligible for a key
- Use of the Green and rink equipment any time they are not in use for competition
- Use of at least one rink during Functions
- · Coaching by club contracted coaches at times arranged by the club or coaches from time to time
- Participation in pennant competition, club championships and club representative competitions (where you are
 eligible and make yourself available for selection), subject to selection by the relevant match committee or
 tournament selectors. Note: Social, Dual and Permit members are not eligible to play in these competitions.
- · Casual games including Gold Coin matches and Twilights during daylight savings

- · Member-priced drinks at the bar
- A vote at the Annual General Meeting and the right to stand for a position an elected position. Note: Social, Junior, Dual and Permit members are not eligible to vote at the AGM or stand for elected positions.

Membership obliges members to observe the Club's Code of Conduct:

- Only flat shoes to be worn, or bare feet, on the Green
- No drinks, including non-alcoholic, on the Green
- No sitting on the bank
- Observe smoking restrictions, particularly no smoking on or around the Green or in the Clubhouse (smoking areas are at the two corners of the Green surrounds at the clubhouse end)
- Limit noise and show respect for our neighbours
- If last to leave, ensure all doors (clubhouse and shed) are locked and lights, fans and air conditioning/heating is turned off.
- Comply with liquor licence requirements and observe Club policy regarding alcohol.
- Comply with the Club's Code of Conduct.
- At all times conduct themselves in a manner that does not reflect unfavourably on the Club
- Ensure the Club environment is free from any anti-social behaviour (on and off the Green) which prevents others from taking part and getting active
- Respect the rights and worth of every person, regardless of their age, race, gender, ability, cultural background, sexuality or religion.
