

## Twilight League 2019/20 Summary

Another successful Twilight League season was completed this year. Participation was up from last season, both in terms of number of participants (34 versus 28) and number of matches played (55 versus 37). The number of prizes awarded and prize money were both increased and newer bowlers secured many of these prizes, attesting to the level playing field created by the competition.

Quarterly prizes were secured by Lindsay, Tim, Peter and Gerry. The top three places were tightly contested to the very end with Rob coming in third (50pts), Lindsay the runner-up (51pts) and Tim the overall winner (54pts).

Twilight League will likely run similarly next season with just a few improvements planned. The aim again will be to provide enjoyable and competitive midweek bowling for players with some competitive experience who are unable to play during the workday. The competition is also intended to help improve bowlers' performance in general and particularly for the fours format encountered in pennant competition.
