Code of Conduct

Club Members will...

- Act within the rules and spirit of our sport. Promote fair play over winning at any cost. Participate for our own enjoyment and benefit. Give your best at all times.
- Treat each person as an individual. Respect the rights and worth of every person, regardless of their age, race, gender, ability, cultural background, sexuality or religion.
- Respect the decisions of officials, coaches and administrators.
- Display responsible behaviour in relation to alcohol and other drugs. No drinks on the green. Observe liquor licence hours - no drinks outside the clubhouse after 9pm.
- Not sit on the bank with feet on the green or in the ditch.
- Wear flat shoes or bare feet on the green. Wear appropriate authorised club uniform when playing pennant.
- Not smoke on the green or in the clubhouse - observe smoking areas (corners of the green only).
- Limit noise - respect our neighbours.
- Act with integrity and objectivity. Accept responsibility for your decisions and actions, ensuring that these contribute to a safe and harassment-free environment. Reject the use of harassment, bullying or violence in any form, whether by other players, spectators, coaches or officials.

Complaints on breaches of the Code should be made in writing to the Board if resolution has not been possible by direct negotiation.
